 1. Principal's Report
 - A) Undesignated Tax Credit /Tutoring:
-Emily let everyone know that there is only \$7,400.00 Undesignated Tax Credit money. 22-23 Tax Credit money has been saved for After School Tutoring. Tutoring is 4 days a week at \$25.00 an hour. We are having trouble finding teachers to sign up to tutor. If the money is not used, it can be moved.
-Emily is working on creating a campaign to create more interest and participation for Tax Credit, possibly using Parent Links and Newsletters
 - B) Facility Report:
-Emily announced that there are issues with air conditioning units in some classrooms and schools district wide. The district is trying to get them repaired as quickly as possible.
 - C) Enrollment: Emily let the team know that enrollment for 23/24 is up compared to 22/23. Marshall is one of few schools that has positive numbers in enrollment. Marshall is completely staffed with no openings. Emily feels these numbers are because Marshall is such a wonderful school to attend and work.
